

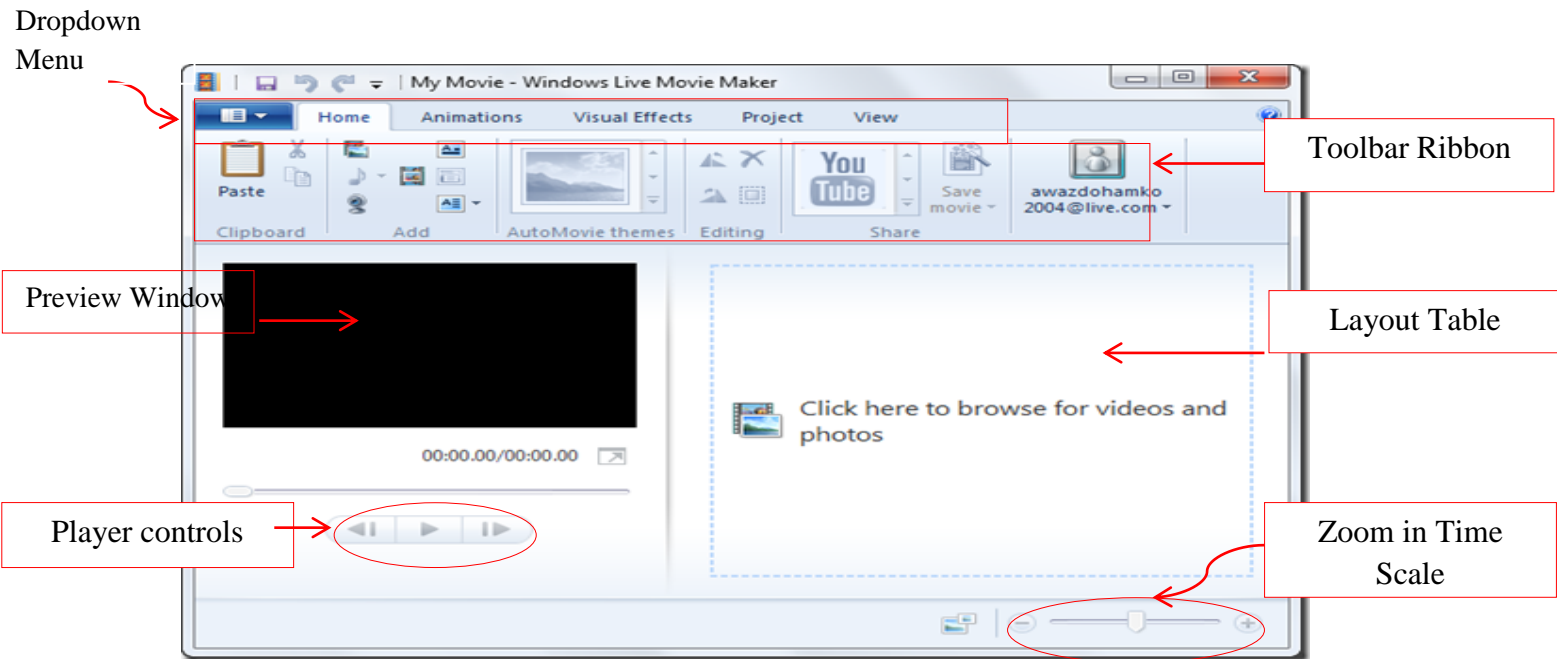
Guide for Windows Movie Maker

Initially, this program should be installed on the PC. This can be done through http://filehippo.com/download_windows_live_movie_maker/download

Open the program Windows Movie Maker.



The following image will appear on the screen of your PC.



Let's start! At first, you must add videos or photos.

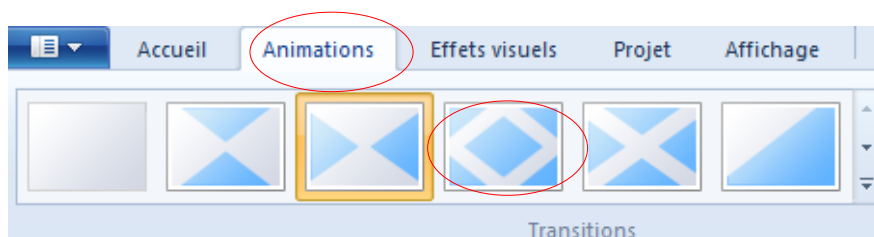
1. Add videos and photos

From the Ribbon toolbar click the *Add videos and photos*. You can select as many files as you want.



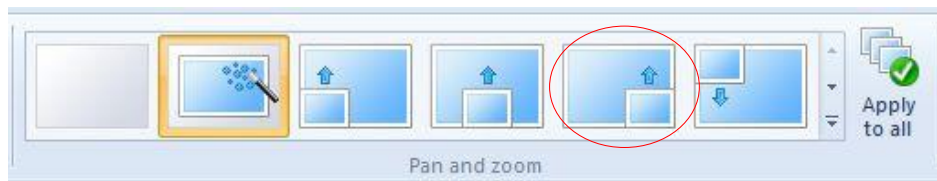
2. Adding transitions from one image (or video) to the next in order to make the project more attractive.

From the *Animations tab* on the dropdown menu,



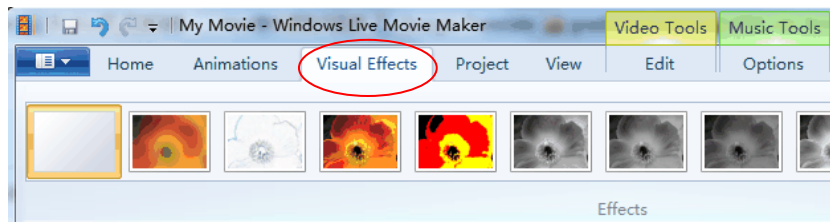
3. Adding effects on a photo.

Click the **animation tab** in the drop-down menu and then choose from the **Pan and zoom**



4. Adding Visual Effects on a photo

For **Visuals Effects tab** in the drop-down menu.



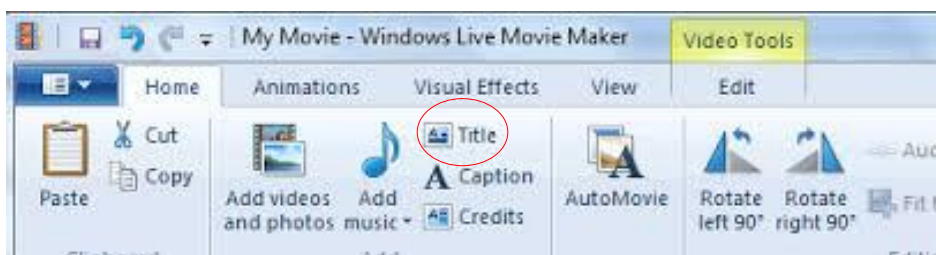
5. Add music on you film to make it more interesting and lively

Click **Add music** and then retract it from the file that is already stored.

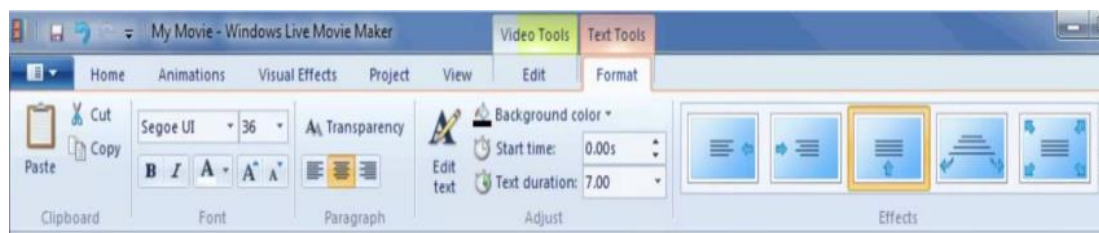


6. Add a title on you film

Click the **Title icon** to enter title for your movie.

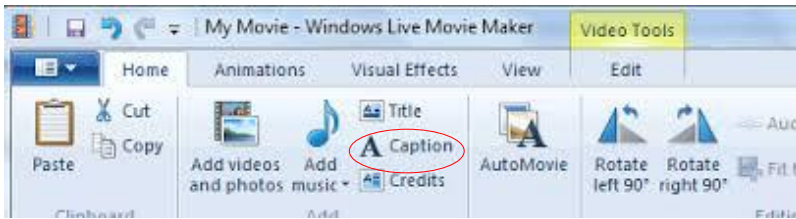


Immediately the following image will appear, and you can configure how you want your title to appear.

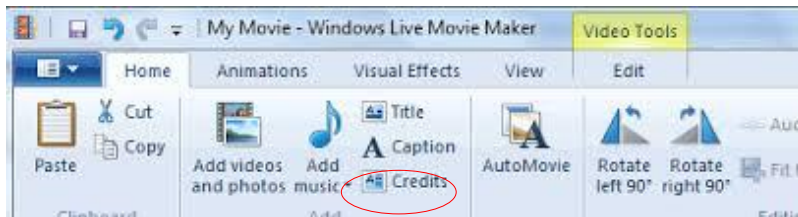


7. Adding caption on the pictures of your film.

Click on the caption icon to enter a caption on your image.



8. Adding end credits to your film to show the producers of the film.



9. Play: To play the movie that you have made, press the button on the *playback controls*.

10. Save project:

Open the drop-down menu (left) and select *Save project as* to save your work.

Once your work has been completed save it as movie from *save movie tab*
